

1 (B) transfer of those functions to the military
2 departments;

3 (C) transfer of those functions to the Office of
4 the Secretary of Defense;

5 (D) transfer of those functions to the Chair-
6 man of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, the commanders
7 of the unified and specified combatant commands,
8 or other joint entities of the Department of De-
9 fense;

10 (E) creation of new defense agencies; and

11 (F) other organizational changes in the De-
12 partment of Defense designed to make the per-
13 formance of those functions more effective, eco-
14 nomical, or efficient.

15 (3) The effect of the amendments made by section
16 1 on ensuring the readiness and responsiveness of the
17 defense agencies in the event of a war or threat to na-
18 tional security and any additional legislation that the
19 Secretary considers necessary to ensure such readiness
20 and responsiveness.

21 (4) Additional legislative or administrative actions
22 that the Secretary considers necessary to ensure effec-
23 tive oversight of defense agency resource management,
24 personnel policies, and budget procedures and to clarify
25 the chain of command.
