

1           (A) may waive the requirement of either  
2           clause (A) or (B) (but not both) of the last sen-  
3           tence of section 2(b)(2) in the case of officers in a  
4           grade above captain or, in the case of the Navy,  
5           lieutenant and below the grade of brigadier gener-  
6           al or rear admiral (lower half); and

7           (B) may waive the requirements of both  
8           clauses (A) and (B) of such sentence in the case of  
9           general and flag officers who have served in joint  
10          assignments.

11          (b) REQUIREMENT FOR SELECTION AS CINC.—Sec-  
12          tion 2(f) shall take effect on January 1, 1991.

13          (c) PROMOTION POLICY.—The amendments made by  
14          section 302 shall take effect with respect to selection boards  
15          convened under section 611(a) of title 10, United States  
16          Code, after the end of the one-year period beginning on the  
17          date of the enactment of this Act.

20          **SEC. 401. REORGANIZATION OF MILITARY DEPARTMENTS BY**  
21                                   **THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE**

22          (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense shall reor-  
23          ganize the executive part of the military departments in ac-  
24          cordance with the provisions of this title.
