10 (1) FUNCTIONS.—The Assistant Secretaries of the
11 military departments shall be assigned the following
12 areas of responsibility by the Secretary of Defense:

14 (B) Reserve affairs functions.

15 (C) Financial management and comptroller
16 functions.

17 (D) Research and development functions.

18 (E) Acquisition functions.

19 (F) Logistics functions.

20 (G) Installations functions.
