

1 (2) Modifications to administrative directives in
2 effect on the date of the enactment of this Act in order
3 to specify that the military chain of command runs
4 from the President to the Secretary of Defense and
5 from the Secretary of Defense through the Chairman
6 of the Joint Chiefs of Staff to the commanders of the
7 unified and specified combatant commands.

8 (3) Provision for a program and budget for each of
9 the unified and specified combatant commands—

10 (A) separate from the programs and budgets
11 of the military department and other elements of
12 the Department of Defense; and

13 (B) developed and administered by the com-
14 manders of those commands under the supervision
15 of the Chairman.

16 (4) Establishment of procedures under which the
17 Chairman (with the support of the Joint Staff and the
18 advice of the other members of the Joint Chiefs of
19 Staff) may recommend to the Secretary of Defense a
20 force posture and five-year defense program to achieve
21 national security objectives within the policy and budg-
22 etary guidelines established by the President and Sec-
23 retary of Defense.
